variable

`this.understand` is a variable. A variable is something that has one value at a time, but can be changed. The shirt you're wearing (or whether or not you're wearing one) is a variable because there is only one value for "shirt" at a time.

while

As long as the terms within `()` are true, the program repeats the actions within the `{}`.

method

`LEARN2CODE();` is calling a method. Method calls have `()` at the end of them. There is code somewhere else labeled "LEARN2CODE" that this method call executes.
